In a final act of true ILCC spirit, Dotty requested in lieu of flowers, a donation be made to the ILCC. As of the writing of this article, the donations have totaled over \$1,000. On behalf of the entire ILCC I would like to express my sincere condolences to the entire Flynn family. Dotty will be greatly missed.
