Keeping that pump gassed up was a constant job and I want to thank John Donahue in particular for making sure the gas cans were filled at all times.

Now that we are in the holiday season, we have many events coming up. The lineup includes the Women's Club Wreath sale, the Men's Club Tree sale, Breakfast with Santa and the annual Holiday Cocktail party. These are always great events and I hope you come out and enjoy them with your ILCC friends.




