President's Message

Hello ILCC Members,

What a great 4th of July we had at the lake! While it may have been a little too hot, we could not have asked for a better day as we all celebrated our nation's birthday on our beautiful lake. From the awesome waterskiing show, to all the parties going on in what seemed like every other backyard, to the sight of the lake lit up by all the flares at night as the fireworks lit up the sky—it truly is the best place to be on this holiday!

After the 4th we turned our attention to Fun Weekend 2019. For those that attended, I'm sure you enjoyed what is always one of the best weekends at the lake. All the preparations were made by our Sports Trustee, Scott Dixon, and all the sub-clubs, so hopefully you did not miss out on the festivities with your fellow lake members. Once inspected by county officials and given the approval to re-open, we had the beaches back open by 3pm. Unfortunately, this is something that can happen in our lake, as we are the only private lake in Morris County with power boats. I am pleased with the way the board members and our beach manager handled the situation and I hope all of our lake members are as well.


