

This is just one court decision, and there are other cases currently being heard, so we will continue to follow these cases, and also wait to see the outcome of the amended legislation and how this all ultimately affects us here in Indian Lake.

Listed below are the details, and we are also accepting donations to keep the guys hydrated and well fed. Volunteers are always needed, so please feel free to swing down and lend a hand. The hours we will be there are: Friday 4:00 pm - 9:00 pm, Saturday 10:00 am - 6:00 pm and Sunday 10:00 am - Until the Last Tree is Sold!
