INDIAN LAKE COMMUNITY CLUB FISHING POLICIES & RULES

- 1. No Ice Fishing
- 2. No fishing from the Lenape Island Bridge.
- 3. No leaving hooks set with bait unattended. You must always be present with your fishing gear.
- 4. No jug (milk jug) fishing of any kind.
- 5. ILCC encourages all anglers to use the "Catch and Release" Philosophy.
- 6. No fishing in any of the designated swim lanes at the Clubhouse property while the swim lanes are still in the water. Once the swim lanes are removed, fishing is permitted in that area.
- 7. No fishing at Clubhouse Beach off the rock jetty or off any of the clubhouse property docks (exception see rule #9) during summer beach hours and/or while lifeguards are on duty. Fishing with just a net will be permitted at all times. (Cast net fishing is not permitted)
- 8. Fishing is strictly prohibited in the rope-off swimming area during the summer months at all times.
- 9. Fishing will be permitted off the far 50' dock on the clubhouse property within the designated fishing area, but all cast must be outside of the swim lanes. (Please note during certain events, ILCC authorized personnel including coaches and lifeguards may close off the dock area for that specific event.)
- 10. Fishing is always prohibited at "Main/Dive Beach" within the gated beach area, including near the diving boards and off the floating dock. Fishing is however permitted beyond the sign that is posted.
- 11. No fishing from the diving pavilion at Main/Dive Beach and floating dock.
- 12. Fishing is strictly prohibited within the gated area of Baby Beach at all times.
- 13. You must clean up after yourself and do not leave hooks or other sharp objects behind as this can cause serious injury.
- 14. Fishing is permitted at all ILCC designated landings including Monkey Island and the lower pond below the parking area at Indian Road.
- 15. Respect other Angler's rights who may also be fishing at the same time.
- 16. When fishing off boats within Indian Lake, please be aware of your surroundings and other boat traffic.
