## Beach Rules (as of June 17, 2025):

All members must always wear their 2025-2026 beach badges. If you are not feeling well, have a fever or any virus-related symptoms, please stay home.

## All beaches will be open daily from 10 am - 7 pm.

- 1. Beaches are open to ILCC members and guests only.
- 2. All children under the age of 13 must always be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- 3. Lifeguards are in charge of the beach while on duty. Failure to follow instructions will result in being asked to leave.
- 4. All children are required to pass a one-time swim test conducted by a lifeguard in order to swim in deep water areas including the swim lanes or utilize the floating dock or diving boards.
- 5. Flotation devices within the beach areas must be approved by the lifeguard on duty.
- 6. No running, pushing, or rough housing on the beaches or docks.
- 7. No diving from the docks.
- 8. If an individual is asked to leave a beach for any reason for bad behavior, they are not permitted at the other two beaches for that day.
- 9. No glass containers permitted on the beach.
- 10. No Alcoholic beverages permitted on the beach at any time unless certain "APPROVED" events permit the same.
- 11. Special events such as parties require advance notice and ILCC board approval.
- 12. In the event of severe weather and "lightning" is reported all patrons must leave the beach area as per the instructions of the lifeguards.
- 13. No dogs are allowed on the beaches at any time.
- 14. No excessive splashing near adults or small children.
- 15. No smoking and/or vaping is permitted on any of the ILCC beaches.
- 16. No Boats are permitted in the swimming areas.
- 17. USE OF THE DIVING BOARDS OUTSIDE OF NORMAL BEACH HOURS IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED.

NJ STATE SANITARY CODE REGULATION 8:26:5.4 (A,B): Do not enter the water if you are experiencing or recovering from diarrhea or have had any signs or symptoms of a gastrointestinal (stomach) disease in the past seven days. All children in diapers must wear swimming diapers. Do not wash out soiled diapers in the bathing water.

Beach tags and privileges may be revoked for non-compliance with any of the above.
